

# CAMP DORA GOLDING CAMPER CLOTHING LIST

The following is a suggested clothing list. Requirements vary with each camper and parents are urged to use their own discretion. Laundry will be sent out to a professional service approximately once every 10 days. Name tapes with camper's **full name** should be sewn securely into every article of clothing. Please pre-wash any new, colored clothing as it tends to run in the wash. Items other than clothing, including luggage, should also be clearly labeled with your son's first and last name. A complete inventory list should be securely placed on the inside of your luggage.

## CLOTHING:

- 5 Pair of long pants
- 5 Pair of shorts
- 11 Polo shirts or T-Shirts
- 2 Long sleeved shirts
- 12 Sets of underwear tops
- 12 Sets of underwear bottoms
- 16 Pairs of socks
- 3 Pairs of tzitzis
- 1 Shabbos outfit
- 4 White shabbos shirts
- 1 Hat ( if applicable)
- 3 Bathing suits
- 2 Camp Dora Golding T-shirts
- 3 Yarmulkas

## NIGHTWEAR:

- 2 Pairs of warm pajamas
- 2 Pairs of light pajamas
- 1 Bathrobe

## OUTERWEAR:

- 1 Heavy sweatshirt or jacket
- 1 Light sweatshirt or jacket
- 1 Raincoat with hood / Poncho

## SHOES:

- 1 Pair of sneakers
- 1 Pair of Shabbos shoes
- 1 Pair of rubbers or boots
- 1 Pair of slippers
- 1 Pair of Tisha B'av sneakers

## LINEN:

- 1 Blanket / Sleeping bag
- 2 Wash clothes
- 2 Bath towels
- 1 Pillow
- 2 Sheets/Pillowcases/Hand towels

## MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:

- Tefillin, Siddur
- 15 self addressed postcards or Envelopes with stamps
- Flashlight & batteries
- Laundry bag
- Small net bag for washing of socks and tzitzis
- Baseball glove & Hockey Stick

## TOILETRIES:

- Toothbrush / Toothpaste
- Soap / Soap dish
- Tissues
- Shampoo
- Deodorant
- Cup & Comb
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent

## OPTIONAL:

- Camera
- Baseball cap
- Good books & Games
- Pens & pencils
- Canteen
- Safety pins
- Wire hangers
- Fishing pole and equipment
- Tennis racket

## ADDITIONAL PACKING LIST FOR YAALUZU MOUNTAINEERING PROGRAM:

- Sleeping bag w/ stuff pack (rated for at least 40 F)
- 2 pairs of hiking socks (wool is best)
- Hiking boots (not snow boots, sneakers or casual shoes)
- Outdoor hat or bandanna
- Canteen or Camelback style water container (at least 4 liters)  
(two empty soda bottles is fine)
- Whistle
- Compass (optional)
- Insect repellent
- Rain poncho (important)
- Non-cotton hiking shirts and pants (optional)
- Bottle of sunscreen SPF 15 or higher
- Pair of junk sneakers or water slippers for Delaware River Trips
- White shirts for Shabbos
